I will have more info for you soon, but these are the pressing issues of the moment and I will appreciate your most immediate response.

October 11, 2007

I need help. I am unable to complete the Grande Roster due to lack of information regarding Locale Chef's and Correspondants or Cheminots and Sous Cheminots for the Districts. The bonding for your Locales is coming in very slowly also.

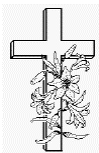
